### Notes

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying St Peter's Brighton.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that St Peter's Brighton reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains equal to the tax that St Peter's Brighton reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, you should ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*.
